NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island Open Meetings Act, R.I.G.L. 42-46-6 (b), the public is hereby notified that the Public Utilities Commission (Commission or PUC) is holding an open meeting on **Tuesday, January 20, 2026 @ 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island for purpose of discussing, deliberating and/or voting on the following dockets. Because this is not a hearing, the PUC will not be accepting oral public comments. The Open Meeting will be streamed live at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

- II. Approval of Open Meeting Minutes from 12/1/25, 12/23/25, and 12/31/25.
- III. **Docket No. 4237 – The Narragansett Electric d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (Company)** – This docket is in accordance with statutory mandates and Commission Orders. Rhode Island Energy filed its 2025 Contact Voltage Annual Report on August 1, 2025 and subsequently filed a correction to the annual report on November 5, 2025. The Division submitted a summary of its review of the Company’s filing, comments and recommendations to adopt. At this Open Meeting the Commission will review the record and a vote will be taken.
- IV. **Docket No. 25-47-EL – The Narragansett Electric d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (Company)** – This docket relates to the 2026 RES Plan submitted to the Public Utilities Commission in accordance with 810-RICR-40-05-2.9. Pursuant to 810-RICR-40-05-2.9(C). The Rhode Island Renewable Energy Standard requires the Company to obtain a statutorily established percentage of its energy supply from eligible renewable energy resources. The 2026 RES Plan is designed to meet the statutory obligations set forth by the RES. On January 5, 2026 the Division provided the Commission with comments stating that it found the filing reasonable and recommended approval as filed. At this Open Meeting the Commission will review the record and a vote will be taken.
- V. **Consent Agenda** – All items listed within the Consent Agenda are to be considered routine by the Commission and will ordinarily be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Commission requests, in which event the item will be removed for separate consideration later on the agenda. As noted below, the agenda includes applications for eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource and PUC consultant’s recommendation on the applications.

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		have a total combined capacity of .21814 MW AC (.22445 MW DC). PUC consultant recommends approval.
RES-25-51	Ameresco	Application for eligibility of the Smithfield RI NCA Solar LLC SFZ-6, Solar Generation Unit 1.494 MW AC (1.905 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Smithfield, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends conditional approval.
RES-25-62	MEVS ASA, LLC	Application for eligibility of the MEVS ASA LLC, Solar Generation Unit .990 MW AC (1.3 MW DC) solar energy facility located in North Smithfield, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends approval.
RES-25-63	Down East Renewable Energy, LLC	Application for eligibility of the 20 Frontage, Solar Generation Unit .75 MW AC (.999 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Westerly, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends conditional approval.
RES-25-65	Sharpe Solar, LLC	Application for eligibility of the Sharpe Solar, Generation Unit .4 MW AC (.495 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Cranston, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends conditional approval.
25-58-TL	Verizon Rhode Island	Verizon RI's Tariff filing proposes an increase of the monthly rate for residential packages. On December 23, 2025 The Division filed a memorandum recommending approval of the proposed amended tariffs as filed to take effect February 1, 2026.
26-02-TL	Zayo Network Services, LLC	Application from Zayo Network Services, LLC for Authority as a Class VI Telecommunications Service Provider in the State of Rhode Island. On January 13, 2026 The Division filed a memorandum recommending approval of the company's application and to grant the company's request for confidential treatment.
