NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island Open Meetings Act, R.I.G.L. 42-46-6 (b), the public is hereby notified that the Public Utilities Commission (Commission or PUC) is holding an open meeting on **Tuesday, July 28, 2026 @ 1:00 P.M.** in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island for purpose of discussing, deliberating and/or voting on the following dockets. Because this is not a hearing, the PUC will not be accepting oral public comments. The Open Meeting will be streamed live at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

- II. Approval of Open Meeting Minutes from 3/27/26, 6/5/26, 6/30/26
- III. **Docket No. 25-32-WW – Narragansett Bay Commission (Company)** – At the Open Meeting held on June 30, 2026, the Commission approved rates in the above-referenced docket. On July 1, 2026, NBC filed Compliance Tariffs and accompanying Compliance Exhibits 1 through 5, which memorialized the approved revenue increase to reflect the Commission’s decisions. On July 2, 2026, NBC filed revised Compliance Exhibits 1 through 5 to correct an error in the previously filed exhibits. The revised Compliance Exhibits do not change the rates in NBC’s Compliance Tariffs that were filed on July 1, 2026. At this Open Meeting, the Commission will review the compliance filings, and a vote will be taken.
- IV. **Docket No. 26-24-WW – Kent County Water Authority (KCWA)** – This Docket relates to KCWA’s June 26, 2026 request to pass through reduced wholesale rates charged by Providence Water Supply Board that were approved in the Commission’s June 24, 2026 decision in Docket No. 24-51-WW. KCWA proposes an effective date of August 1, 2026. On July 14, 2026, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers submitted a memorandum reviewing the filing and recommending that the proposed rates be approved, finding them to comply with the Commission’s June 26, 2026 decision. At this Open Meeting the Commission will consider the filings and vote on the rate change.
- V. **Docket No. 26-09-EL – The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (Company)** – This docket pertains to the Company’s tariff advice filing to amend the Long Term Contracting for Renewable Energy Recovery and Reconciliation Provisions, RIPUC Nos. 2272 and 2267. On June 5, 2026, the Commission suspended the date on which the Company’s proposed tariffs would take effect. On July 21, 2026, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers recommended approval of the proposed tariffs. At this Open Meeting, the Commission will review the filings and may vote on the proposed tariffs.
- VI. **Docket No. 26-15-EE – Least Cost Procurement Standards (LCP Standards)** - Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-27.7(a), Commission has adopted LCP Standards. The LCP Standards are subject to periodic review and amendment by the PUC not less frequently than every three years after adoption. In this docket, the PUC has commenced review of the current LCP Standards adopted on July 27, 2023. Draft LCP Standards were issued for comment on May 12, 2026. While the Commission is still reviewing the comments, there is one item to be addressed - the filing deadline for the 2027 Energy Efficiency Plan filing. The Commission staff had originally recommended a September 1, 2026 filing date, one month earlier than in the current standards

(Draft LCP Standards § 3.4.D). After having reviewed the comments and based on the timing of the review of the comments, Staff recommends that to avoid any confusion, the Commission confirm that the filing date for the 2027 Plan (whether or not a one-year or three-year plan be required) remain on October 1, 2026. At this Open Meeting the Commission will consider the recommendation and may vote. No other comments will be considered at this open meeting.

- VII. Consent Agenda** – All items listed within the Consent Agenda are to be considered routine by the Commission and will ordinarily be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Commission requests, in which event the item will be removed for separate consideration later on the agenda. As noted below, the agenda includes applications from telecommunications providers and eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource and PUC consultant’s recommendation on the applications.

Docket #	Applicant	Filing
RES-23-01	Sunnova Energy International, Inc	Application to add 24 customer sited Generation Units to its Sunstrong-Rhode Island Aggregation for eligibility as New Renewable Energy Resources. The Generation Units are located in Rhode Island and have achieved operations and have a total combined capacity of .15856 MW AC (.17551 MW DC). PUC consultant recommends approval.
RES-26-16	Wunder Power BAV91, LLC	Application for eligibility of the RI10 Solar, Generation Unit .2 MW AC (.2463 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Woonsocket, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends conditional approval.
RES-26-17	Wunder Power BAV91, LLC	Application for eligibility of the RI06 Solar, Generation Unit .099 MW AC (.1585 MW DC) solar energy facility located in Cranston, Rhode Island. PUC consultant recommends conditional approval.
