2. The Board may discuss and vote to adopt a Drop Box regulation for use in the March 2, 2021 Statewide Special Referenda Election consistent with the Drop Box regulation adopted for the September 8, 2020 Primary and the November 3, 2020 General Election.
3. The Board may discuss and vote upon the topics to be presented by Executive Director Robert Rapoza to the Senate Committee on Rules, Government Ethics and Oversight on February 1, 2021, concerning the modifications to the elections process for the 2020 Presidential Preference Primary, Statewide Primary and the General Election, and the Board's recommend changes to the elections process, including, in-person signature collection for nomination papers, certification process for mail ballots, method of notification of public certification sessions, extension of time to conduct certification process and modification of deadlines to submit regular mail ballot and emergency mail ballot applications.
