1. The Board may discuss and vote to approve the minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday July 14, 2021.
2. The Board may discuss and vote to form a Task Force to improve access to mail ballot voting and transmission securely for the military, overseas and disabled voters.
3. The Board may discuss and vote to approve the polling locations for the Special Election Primary for East Greenwich School Committee on **Tuesday, September 7, 2021** and the Special Election for East Greenwich School Committee on **Tuesday, October 5, 2021**.
4. The Board may discuss and vote to authorize the staff to commence mail ballot certification for the **September 7, 2021** Special Election Primary for East Greenwich School Committee beginning no earlier than **Tuesday, August 24, 2021 at 1:00 p.m.** and continuing as needed during business hours through **Tuesday, September 14, 2021**.
5. The Board may discuss and vote to support the purchase of the ES&S Expressvote to replace the current AutoMark voting equipment which has been in use since 2006 after a demonstration of the Expressvote equipment by ES&S.

6. The Board may vote to meet in executive session, pursuant to R.I. General Laws § 42-46-5(a)(2) regarding a lawsuit pending in Providence County Superior Court, captioned, *Robert Kando v. Rhode Island State Board of Elections, et al.*, C.A. No. PC-2017-4918.
