**AMENDED NOTICE OF OPEN MEETING**

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island Open Meetings Act, R.I.G.L. 42-46-6 (b), the public is hereby notified that the Public Utilities Commission (Commission or PUC) is holding an open meeting on **Friday, March 19, 2021 @ 10:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island for purpose of discussing, deliberating and/or voting on the following dockets. Because this is not a hearing, the PUC will not be accepting oral public comments. The Open Meeting will be streamed live at <http://www.ustream.tv/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

I. Call to Order

II. **Docket No. 5022 - Suspension of Service Terminations and Certain Collections Activities During the COVID-19 Emergency** - The Commission will consider and vote on whether an emergency still exists and whether circumstances exist which necessitate the need to extend the utility termination moratorium as defined by the Commission's Rules and Regulations Governing the Termination of residential Electric, Gas and Water Service (810 RICR-10-00-1), currently set to expire on April 15, 2021, through June 25, 2021, the last day of school on the Statewide school calendar, for customers of The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (electric and gas). The Commission will consider requiring Pascoag Utility District and Block Island Utility District to provide additional flexibility for customers in arrears.

III. **Docket No. 4373 – Interstate Navigation Co. (Company)** – This docket relates to the Commission reviews the Company's earnings. The Commission will consider and rule on the February 18, 2021 Settlement Agreement between the Division of Public Utilities and Interstate Navigation Co. regarding the disposition of the current overage of funds in the Company's fuel surcharge reserve account.

IV. **Providers of Telecommunications Service** – The Commission will review and vote on the application for registration to provide telecommunications service submitted in the following dockets:

**Docket No. 5123 – Combined Public Communications, LLC (Company)** – The Company applied for approval as a Class V Telecommunication Supplier (to offer Inmate Services). The application included a request for confidential treatment of the Company's financial statements, Exhibit 2.

**Docket No. 5125 – Hughes Network Systems, LLC** – The Company applied for approval as a Class VI Telecommunications Supplier (to offer VoIP service).

**Docket No. 5132 – Advanced Corporate Networks (Company)** - The Company applied for approval as a Class V Telecommunications Supplier (Wholesaler of Data Services). The

application included a request for confidential treatment the company's financial statements, Exhibit D.

**V. Eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource** – Review and rule on the application for eligibility as a Renewable Energy Resource as submitted in the following dockets:

**Docket No. 5104 – Diamond Hill Solar, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the 3100 Diamond Hill Road Solar generation unit, a 0.199 MW AC ( 0.249 MW DC) solar facility located in Cumberland, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5105 – Bluestone Development Group, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the One Angell Road Solar generation unit, a 0.206 MW AC (0.248 MW DC) solar facility located in Cumberland, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5107 – Vikon Solar, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the Vikon Solar generation unit, a 0.300 MW AC (0.380 MW DC) solar facility located in Lincoln, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5109 – 1519 Crandall Road, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the Tiverton – Crandall Road 1 generation unit, a 1.826 MW AC (2.581 MW DC) solar facility located in Tiverton, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5110 – 1519 Crandall Road, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the Tiverton – Crandall Road 2 generation unit, a 1.660 MW AC (2.371 MW DC) solar facility located in Tiverton, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5115 – Rooftop 344, LLC (Company)** - The Company applied for eligibility of the Rooftop 344, LLC generation unit, a 0.120 MW AC (0.1505 MW DC) solar facility located in Middletown, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**Docket No. 5117 – University Solar 2, LLC (Company)** – The Company applied for eligibility of the University Solar 2, LLC generation unit, a 4.0 MW AC (5.305 MW DC) solar facility located in West Greenwich, Rhode Island as a New Renewable Energy Resource.

**VI. Docket Nos. 5113 and 5114 - The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid** – These dockets relate to National Grid's proposed Updated Advanced Metering Functionality (AMF) Business Case in Docket 5113 and Grid Modernization Plan in Docket 5114. The Commission will discuss and vote whether to consolidate these dockets.

**VII. Docket No. 5099 – The Narragansett Electric Co. d/b/a National Grid** – This docket relates to the PUC’s review of National Grid’s Gas Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability Plan for FY 2022. The PUC will have a review of the record and discussion of outstanding issues, including a discussion relating to the Company’s proposal to assess alternative solutions that address risks on Aquidneck Island. No votes will be taken.
