**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) hereby gives notice that it will conduct a public comment hearing on **Wednesday, September 2, 2026 @ 11:00 A.M** at Prudence Improvement Association, 620 Narragansett Ave, Prudence Island, RI 02872. The purpose of this hearing is to take public comments on A&R Marine Corp. d/b/a Prudence & Bay Island Transport's (A&R) proposed rate changes.

A&R's proposed rate and tariff changes are designed to increase revenues by \$683,782 and collect total revenues of \$1,999,791. The impact of the proposal as currently filed is an increase of 51.96% in revenue requirement. The company proposed to have new rates go into effect on April 9, 2026. On March 27, 2026, the PUC suspended the effective date for rates to go into effect to no later than December 9, 2026, to allow for further investigation. Table 1 below represents proposed customer impacts for certain rate classes.
