- Maintenance Fund: \$52,300.00

Old Business

- Price adjustments: Both vendors were willing to work with us on pricing. Boulevard reduced the price for stump removal from \$325 to \$250 and North-Eastern Tree Service reduced the price for removing the debris from Valley Park from \$1,080 to \$700.
- Review the location for street planting. Bob has persuaded the HOA at Wyndham Hill to share the cost of stump removal and tree planting. (THANK YOU!!!).
- I notified North-Eastern Tree Service they can begin maintenance whenever they can schedule. I asked them to let us know when they are done so the Tree Warden can take a look and if there are any concerns they can be addressed.
- Review maintenance plans: Ron sent the maintenance plans for the plans we reviewed at the last meeting.
- Review West House II landscape plans.
- Approval by Town Council for 2 memorial trees in Valley Park. One other inquiry.
- Valley Park grass cutting. THANK YOU!!!! Maintenance survey
- Earth Week Celebration: 100 red maples were ordered and will be distributed with an activity for children from the Children's Room at the library. In addition, I will hand out tree seedlings on Saturday, April 23rd from 1-3 at the library. This will be our Arbor Day celebration required for Tree City Status. The Town Council will provide an Arbor Day Proclamation on April 4th.

New Business:

- Request by homeowner at 412 Wolcott for a determination if a tree is a public or private tree and what can be done to remove/replace the tree.
- Request by homeowner about the potential replacement of 3 old trees at 246 Paradise Ave.
- Request by homeowner at 49 Indian Ave to plant tupelo instead of gingko as replacement trees for the oaks they asked to remove.
- Complaint by homeowner about neighbor's tree impacting her property.
