Approval of the August 28th meeting minutes.

PROJECT REVIEW

1. CASE 23.097, 72 MOORE STREET, House, c1895 (NORTH ELMWOOD)

The applicant is requesting the installation of 14 solar panels in two rows to the west slope of the gable-end roof.

2. CASE 23.107, 404 SOUTH MAIN (aka 12 JAMES) STREET, Joseph Tillinghast House, 1801 (COLLEGE HILL)

The applicant is requesting the installation of 19 solar panels, 12 to the south slope of the main house's gable-end roof, two to the rear ell's south slope's gable-end roof, and five on the west slope of carriage house's gable roof.

3. CASE 23.108, 159 SUTTON STREET, Barnaby Carriage House, 1875 (BROADWAY)

The applicant is requesting the installation of 19 solar panels, in two nine-panel arrays to the flat of the mansard roof.

4. CASE 23.109, 230 ATLANTIC AVENUE, Joseph W. Padelford House, c1877 (SOUTH ELMWOOD)

The applicant is requesting the installation of 16 solar panels to the sides (five: west slope & five: east slope) and rear (six: south slope) upper-hip roof atop the mansard roof.

5. CASE 23.110, 39 WOOD STREET, House, post1870 (ARMORY)

The applicant is requesting the removal of the existing slate roof and installation of architectural shingles.

6. CASE 23.111, 535 BROADWAY, House, c1880 (BROADWAY)

The applicant is requesting the removal of seven sashes in a portion of the first floor to the side (west) and rear (north) side of the building and the installation of insulated replacement sashes.

7. CASE 23.112, 545 BROADWAY, Vacant Lot (BROAWAY)

The applicant is requesting the new construction of a three-story, three-unit house.

8. CASE 23.113, 183 CONGRESS AVENUE, Vacant Lot (SOUTH ELMWOOD)

The applicant is requesting the new construction of a 2½-story, two-unit house.
