2. DISCUSSION ITEMS

Athletics Director Thorr Bjorn provided a PowerPoint presentation to the Committee on the topics listed below.

a. NCAA Updates – Student Athlete Holistic Model Enclosure 2.a.

- Thorr Bjorn, Athletics Director

Director Bjorn reported that beginning in August 2024, URI Athletics has implemented several collaborative initiatives to create a holistic approach for excellence for student-athletes as it relates to medical issues (working with team doctors) and mental health services, and working with expert personnel on campus, assuring compliance with treating the whole person. URI Athletics has an existing relationship with the Psychological Consultation Center (PCC) to facilitate mental health support for student athletes.

b. NIL Update – URI National Landscape

- Thorr Bjorn, Director, Athletics
- Kacey Light, Associate Athletic Director NCAA Compliance

Director Bjorn reported on NIL (Name, Image, and Likeness) and focused on programs that the Athletics Department partners with (OpendorseTM and the Rhode to Excellence Collective) to monetize student athletes' NIL or to pursue entrepreneurship. He talked about what is and is not allowable and added that the NCAA places restrictions on colleges and universities by not allowing them to use NIL in recruitment efforts. He also outlined NIL's institutional involvement and what was permissible and impermissible in how an institution can promote NIL.

Director Bjorn shared the goals of and data from the Opendorse[™] and Rhode to Excellence Collective and their three major goals to educate, support and encourage student athletes. He noted that URI is offering additional educational opportunities for student athletes as it relates to NIL and helping athletes create and enhance their brand.

c. Transfer Portal Updates - URI and National Landscape

- Thorr Bjorn, Director, Athletics
- Kacey Light, Associate Director, NCAA Compliance

Athletic Director Bjorn began by explaining the changes made to the transfer portal by the NCAA. He indicated that many of the past restrictions placed on student athletes, which can create recruitment challenges for the URI Athletics organization, had been changed. Director Bjorn also reported that for any student-athlete transfer awarded aid, URI Athletics must guarantee their award scholarship for the athlete's period of availability. Associate Director Light shared updated data about where URI student athletes landed once they entered the transfer portal.
