NOTICE

Who qualifies to vote at the Annual Meeting?

A "qualified voter" is (1) any person whose name appears on an active account with the Pascoag Utility District; and (2) in addition, who either resides in the Village of Pascoag or who owns property in the Village of Pascoag.

All meetings of the Pascoag Utility District are subject to the Open Meeting Laws, which includes requirements for access by those with special needs. The Pascoag Utility District Business Office is accessible to persons with disabilities.
