This will be a conceptual level review of the project and will be the first of two reviews before the Commission.
- **5. Major TIP Amendment** (*For Action*) The Rhode Island Department of Transportation has requested a major amendment to the State Transportation Improvement Plan, including a reduction in the "Transportation Alternatives" program. The Transportation Advisory Committee of the State Planning Council has authorized a public comment period and the BPAC may discuss any desired formal sentiments during this agenda item.
- **6. Dean Street Viaduct** *(For Action)* The Rhode Island Department of Transportation is planning some work on the Dean Street Viaduct, which has been previously identified by the Commission as a priority for the city's bike network. This will be a conceptual level review of the project and will be the first of two reviews before the Commission.
- 7. Dexter Street and Parade Street West End Ward 13 (For Action) The City of Providence Department of Planning and Development seeks comments from the BPAC regarding alternatives for reconfiguring Dexter and Parade streets around the Dexter Training Ground. There are no conceptual plans for the Commission to review at this time, but rather several alternatives for parking and mobility lane configurations regarding which the Commission may express preference.
- **8.** Complete Streets Master Plan (For Action) The City of Providence Department of Planning and Development seeks comments from the BPAC regarding the Complete Streets Master Plan. This will be the first of numerous opportunities for the public to provide input into this vision for future investments in the public realm.
